



## Troop 226 Aluminum Can Recycling Procedures

- Try to get 5-10 of your closest neighbors or family to collect aluminum cans.
- Use the handout letter to help explain the procedures to your neighbors.
- Add neighbors to your list if you feel that you can handle the extra workload and storage of cans until the following Tuesday night Troop Meeting or drop at my home.
- Collect, Clean, Crush and Seal your aluminum cans in plastic trash bags.
- Bring your cans to the Troop Meeting and place them in the back of Mr. Jeff's truck.
- You can bring additional crushed, plastic bag sealed Aluminum cans to my house at any time and place on my front porch at 5500 Rice Drive. NE Corner of Squires and Rice off N Colony Blvd.

- AAA in Lewisville just paid us \$0.67 per pound. This is awesome! It takes roughly 32 cans to make a pound of aluminum. If you know of a better deal, please let me know.
- The weekend collection dates for your neighbor's/family's aluminum are any time you specify...just remember to get them on time when stated and to bring to every Troop meeting. Your word is all they have and keeping your word earns your neighbors and family's respect.
- You will bring your aluminum to the following Tuesday night Troop meetings or to my home at any time. Please make sure they are cleaned, crushed and in sealed plastic bags! Please no trash other than cans as we are docked \$0.10 per pound for having trash.
