- ✓ 4 – Metal bowls
- ✓ 1 – Cutting board
- ✓ 2 – Knives
- ✓ 1 – Colander
- ✓ 2 – Pots w/handles
- ✓ 2 - Lids
- ✓ 1 – Skillet
- ✓ 2 – Potholders
- ✓ 1 – Utensil Bag
- ✓ 1 – Propane tree
- ✓ 1 – Propane hose
- ✓ 1 – Lantern
- ✓ 1 – Stove
- ✓ 1 – Griddle for stove
- ✓ 1 – Paper Towels (optional)

Utensil bag

- ✓ 1 – Potato masher
- ✓ 1 – Plastic tongs
- ✓ 1 – Metal tongs
- ✓ 1 – Wisk
- ✓ 2 – Rubber spatulas
- ✓ 1 – Potato peeler
- ✓ 1 – Metal spatula
- ✓ 1 – Metal slotted spoon
- ✓ 1 – Plastic Spoon
- ✓ 1 – Pasta spoon
- ✓ 1 – Can opener
- ✓ 1 – Spoon rest
- ✓ 4 – Dry measuring cups
- ✓ 4 – Measuring spoons
- ✓ 1 – Liquid measuring cup

All items should be cleaned, dried, inventoried and put away in the proper place after each campout. Any missing or damaged items should be reported to the Quartermaster as soon as possible. Request additional gear not listed above from the quartermaster in advance if needed.

Wet equipment or water inside the chuckbox will mildew between campouts! Do not put dirty dishes in the chuckbox.
